Highlighted:

- Administrative position added with \$7000 budget to assist with paperwork for submissions, responsibilities during show preparation, TTF, etc. Job description to follow
- TTF defined by Ms. Stucker: workshops can be attended by any interested student. Only 15 entries per school for the competition. Going to emphasize participation by ALL that want to attend. **Boosters fund the event UP FRONT but students must pay back to attend. Deposit will be asked on 17th Aug.
- Proposal to host Variety Show at CHS to save money. Spend money on decor to "shoosh" it up (thank you, Grace)
- Question on low cost shown for Banquet –discussion to look for other cheaper venues and make more inclusive feel. It budget amendment required at mid year review this can be done. Action: BM to Identify Banquet lead to shop venues
- Line item for concessions this year instead of asking parents to donate
- Comparison to other extracurriculars \$\$ & other ISDs
- Program Fees per class (increases as the classes advance) **discussion on sponsorships and fundraising if needed and waving costs for families requiring financial aid.
- CHS9–director described the different theatre electives. Added a more advanced class: proposing Take One Competition (\$200), as well as Take

One (\$75) & basic course (Spotlight) for FA credit. Collin proposed increasing program fee for advanced class and Tech course and removing charge to Theatre One.

Deliberation on amounts (esp from returning actors). Laura emphasized attention needs to be paid that the program fees are not the end of cost to performers.

Amy Kryzak proposed and Jennifer Bunting and Brittany Reese seconded ratifying Budget.
